- 1. Approve January 5, 2022 Minutes Any business arising
- 2. Covid Restriction Updates per Province:

NB – NEW – Moving to Level 2 midnight Jan 28. U12 able to return to sport. Small competitions permitted for alpine skiing.

NS – Training of cohorts up to 25 participants. No competitions within NS. Can conduct timed runs but not for purposes of publishing and ranking. Can travel outside NS for training and comp. Restrictions until at least Feb 14, however, Strang stated the intent is to get sport events up and running asap

PE – Training permitted. No competitions for any age groups until Jan 17. Will be reassessed at that time. Hill is shut down due to CWG construction. Won't open until some time in Feb. Individuals can leave province to train but must isolate for 4 days upon return. Back to school Jan 31.

NL – Training permitted within group but no competitions. No restriction on numbers. Rapid test, 24 hrs after 2 negatives don't have to isolate.
